- 2 **SEC. 2001. RECONCILIATION IN THE SENATE.**
- 3 (a) COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE.—The Committee
- 4 on Agriculture of the Senate shall report changes in laws
- 5 within its jurisdiction that reduce the deficit for fiscal year
- 6 2018 by not less than \$4,800,000,000.
- 7 (b) COMMITTEE ON ARMED SERVICES.—The Com-
- 8 mittee on Armed Services of the Senate shall report
- 9 changes in laws within its jurisdiction that reduce the def-
- 10 icit for fiscal year 2018 by not less than \$480,000,000.

1 (c) COMMITTEE ON HEALTH, EDUCATION, LABOR,  
2 AND PENSIONS.—The Committee on Health, Education,  
3 Labor, and Pensions of the Senate shall report changes  
4 in laws within its jurisdiction that reduce the deficit for  
5 fiscal year 2018 by not less than \$9,660,000,000.

6 (d) COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND NATURAL RE-  
7 SOURCES.—The Committee on Energy and Natural Re-  
8 sources of the Senate shall report changes in laws within  
9 its jurisdiction that reduce the deficit for fiscal year 2018  
10 by not less than \$12,070,000,000.

11 (e) COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.—The Committee on  
12 Finance of the Senate shall report changes in laws within  
13 its jurisdiction that—

14 (1) reduce new budget authority for fiscal year  
15 2018 by not less than \$25,100,000,000; and

16 (2) that increase the deficit by not more than  
17 \$1,500,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years  
18 2018 through 2027.

19 (f) COMMITTEE ON BANKING, HOUSING, AND URBAN  
20 AFFAIRS.—The Committee on Banking, Housing, and  
21 Urban Affairs of the Senate shall report changes in laws  
22 within its jurisdiction that reduce the deficit for fiscal year  
23 2018 by not less than \$6,760,000,000.

24 (g) COMMITTEE ON HOMELAND SECURITY AND GOV-  
25 ERNMENTAL AFFAIRS.—The Committee on Homeland Se-

1 ecurity and Governmental Affairs of the Senate shall report  
2 changes in laws within its jurisdiction that reduce the def-  
3 icit for fiscal year 2018 by not less than \$16,900,000,000.

4 (h) COMMITTEE ON THE JUDICIARY.—The Com-  
5 mittee on the Judiciary of the Senate shall report changes  
6 in laws within its jurisdiction that reduce the deficit for  
7 fiscal year 2018 by not less than \$21,720,000,000.

8 (i) COMMITTEE ON VETERANS' AFFAIRS.—The Com-  
9 mittee on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate shall report  
10 changes in laws within its jurisdiction that reduce the def-  
11 icit for fiscal year 2018 by not less than \$480,000,000.

12 (j) SUBMISSIONS.—In the Senate, not later than No-  
13 vember 13, 2017, the Committees named in subsections  
14 (a) through (i) shall submit their recommendations to the  
15 Committee on the Budget of the Senate. Upon receiving  
16 such recommendations, the Committee on the Budget of  
17 the Senate shall report to the Senate a reconciliation bill  
18 carrying out all such recommendations without any sub-  
19 stantive revision.
